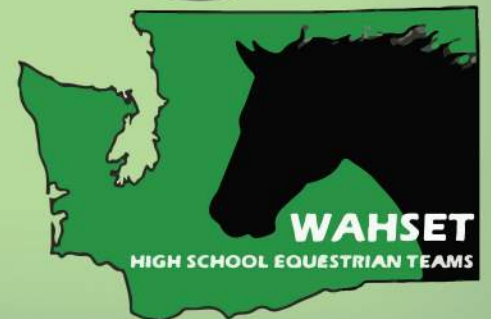

Things to Know about WAHSET

- There is no 'set' skill level. All skills welcome.
- It encompasses seven districts. Five in Western Washington and two in Eastern Washington. Each school is assigned a specific district. Look at the website to see if your school is already involved!
- Each team sets its own practices and has its own start and end times. Although practices vary, they all start in late fall after registration is complete.
- Each team competes in three district meets. These can be at any approved arena located throughout Washington State. The meets typically occur January-April and consist of three-day events (Friday-Sunday)
- There is a state competition for district qualifiers that occurs in the middle of May.
- Starting in 2014, there is now a Regional competition called the Pacific NW Invitational that sets the top five WAHSET competitors against the top five OHSET Competitors. This usually occurs at the end of June.
